Sunrise

- You reaffirmed your statements that the selection of a development concept was a matter for the Sunrise JV consistent with the treaty obligations. You indicated you are aware of recent comments by Ramos Horta and Mari Alkatiri concerning treaty obligations.
- Don Voelte advised that at all times Woodside would meet their ASX-listing requirements and would announce to the market when a decision on a development concept had been selected by the Sunrise JV. Governments and regulators would be advised and Woodside intend to lodge a preliminary field development plan with both regulators.

Browse

- Don Voelte noted recent developments concerning native title in the Kimberley and discussed various options before the WA State Government to progress the development.
- You noted discussions concerning local tourism impacts on Broome from the proposed development and the Kimberley National Landscape.
