

Mark Wilson, Director Markets, Australian Energy Regulator

Mark has an Honours degree in Electrical and Electronic Engineering and 20 years experience in the power industry – seven years in regulation and policy and 13 years in operations.

Over the last seven years he has been responsible for monitoring compliance and investigating and prosecuting breaches of the National Electricity Law and the National Electricity Code (and now the Rules). Initially this was with the National Electricity Code Administrator, and with the changes to the governance arrangements in mid-2005 he continued in a similar role with the Australian Energy Regulator as Director Markets.

From 1999 – 2005 he also performed the role of Secretary to NECA's Reliability Panel, responsible for:

- developing policies and guidelines relating to the power system security and reliability standards for approval by the Panel; and
- reviewing the performance of the market in terms of power system security and reliability.
