Consultation Mailing List – Renewable and Distributed Generation

The Ministerial Council on Energy announced the establishment of the Renewable and Distributed Generation Working Group via its [Communiqué](#) on 27 August 2004 to consider policy directions required for removing impediments to, and promoting the commercial uptake of renewable and distributed generation technologies and practices in the Australian energy market.

The working group is responsible for wind energy policy, the development of a national Code of Practice for Embedded Generation, and the Improving Grid Accessibility initiative announced in the Australian Government's Energy White Paper in June 2004.

The MCE website (www.mce.gov.au) will be the primary source of information dissemination on the renewable and distributed generation work program. Information Bulletins and other relevant information will be posted on the MCE website and distributed by e-mail to those who register for the mailing list.

The MCE established the Renewable and Distributed Generation Working Group separate to the Energy Market Reform work program. We expect that different stakeholders will be interested in receiving information.
